

SANTA CLARA STATION AREA PLAN

Visioning Workshop

August 28, 2006

The City of Santa Clara, City of San José, and Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) are working together on a plan for the area around the Santa Clara Transit Center. Already a transit hub, with its location along Caltrain, ACE, and Capitol rail corridors, and proximity to El Camino Real and Santa Clara University, the Transit Center will be the future terminus of BART's Silicon Valley extension. With completion of BART and construction of an Automated People Mover to the adjacent Norman Y. Mineta International Airport, the Transit Center is projected to become one of the largest transportation and activity centers in the Bay Area.

The Santa Clara Station Area Plan will provide direction for development of 432 acres surrounding the Transit Center. The Plan will seek development of the area as a vibrant and intense destination, with a broad mix of transit-supportive uses. In addition, pedestrian, bicycle, and street connections from the adjacent Santa Clara University and residential neighborhoods will be examined.

On Monday, August 28, community members are invited to join staff from VTA and the cities of Santa Clara and San José for the Santa Clara Station Area Plan Visioning Workshop. The first in a series of community workshops for the Station Area Plan, this event will focus on visions and ideas for the future. (Subsequent workshops will examine alternatives and supporting plans.) Workshop participants will be involved in hands-on activities to identify key issues for the planning team to address for the Station Area Plan.
