The City of San Jose Planning, Building and Code Enforcement and the District 3 Council office would like to invite you to a community meeting for the proposed Trinity Residential Care Facility located at 341 N. 5<sup>th</sup> Street. The Conditional Use Permit would allow conversion of a single-family residence to a Residential Care Facility for up to 12 residents and 2 staff on a 0.20 gross acre site.

**Community Meeting:** On December 6, 2006, the Planning Commission held a public hearing to consider the proposed project. The Planning Commission continued the project to an undetermined date within 120 days so that additional public outreach could be conducted with the neighborhood.

At the meeting, Planning staff will distribute agenda and information packets containing all documents and written correspondence submitted on the project to date. Planning staff will facilitate a mediation between the applicant and neighbors to enable a better understanding of various points of view.
