The property owner of the San Jose Medical Center site, Hospital Corporation of America (HCA), and City of San José Planning Division staff would like to invite you to a community meeting to discuss the proposed demolition of the San Jose Medical Center buildings. The application on file with the City is a Planned Development Permit request (file no. PD07-008) to allow the demolition of nine buildings, totaling approximately 285,500 square feet, on the former San Jose Medical Center site. The buildings that would remain on the site include the San Jose Mediplex Building at 725 E. Santa Clara Street and Building 800 on E. Saint John Street (see Figure 2 on reverse).

The meeting also serves as an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) public scoping meeting for City staff to describe the proposed project's environmental review process, and to obtain your input on the EIR analysis for the proposal. You are welcome to attend and give us your input on the scope of the EIR so that it addresses all relevant environmental issues. There will also be an open forum for questions and comments.




