The Department of Planning, Building, and Code Enforcement would like to invite you to a meeting to discuss a proposed interim ordinance to establish a temporary moratorium on the establishment of new bail bond businesses in the City of San Jose. The interim ordinance is being considered at the direction of City Council in response to neighborhood concern regarding the existing concentration of bail bond establishments in the vicinity of North First Street between Jackson and Interstate 880 and the impact of these businesses on the surrounding neighborhood.

A temporary moratorium would prevent the establishment of new bail bond businesses and avoid any potential neighborhood impacts that may be associated with these businesses while the City reviews and possibly amends regulations of Title 20 of the San Jose Municipal Code (the zoning Ordinance) relative to bail bond establishments.
