

## City of San Jose Planning Division Map Sales Information

This map sales information sheet provides basic information about the most commonly requested maps prepared by the City of San Jose Planning Division. This information includes the geographic coverage, source, count, size, scale, and cost of maps.

The Planning Division's maps fall into two broad categories: Standard and Custom. Standard maps include: (1) the General Plan Land Use/Transportation Diagram, (2) Zoning maps, and (3) City Council District boundary maps, as described below and as shown on the Maps/Data page of the City's website (<http://www.sanjoseca.gov/planning/data/>). Custom maps, on the other hand, could be of any variety that utilizes geographic data owned and maintained by the City of San Jose.

Most requests for the printing of standard maps by the City of San Jose can be completed within 48 hours. However, please note that large and/or custom map requests may require a longer preparation time. To place a standard map order or discuss a custom map request, please contact the City of San Jose Planning Division at (408) 535-7896.

### **General Plan Land Use/Transportation Diagram**

General Plan Land Use/Transportation Diagram (GP) maps are available either from the City of San Jose ([http://www.sanjoseca.gov/planning/gp\\_maps/default.asp](http://www.sanjoseca.gov/planning/gp_maps/default.asp)) or from ARC (<http://www.e-arc.com/>), as specified below. Maps from the City of San Jose may be obtained at San Jose City Hall, 200 E. Santa Clara Street, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor. Maps from ARC may be obtained at the 835 W. Julian Street location (see location map, page 2).

### **Zoning Maps**

Zoning maps are only produced at the grid/panel geographic coverage. ## Digital Data

The digital Geographic Information Systems (GIS) data used by the Planning Division to prepare maps may be obtained free-of-charge. These data are stored in MapInfo (TAB) file format, and have an NAD 1983, California Zone 3, survey feet projection. The City can generally accommodate requests for file type translation.
