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You are welcome to attend and give us your input on the scope of the EIR so that it addresses all relevant environmental issues. The project for which the EIR is being prepared is:

Project Description: The Water Pollution Control Plant Master Plan project proposes a number of technical improvements to the San Jose/Santa Clara Water Pollution Control Plant and changes to the land use of the Plant’s 2,684 acres. The technical improvements include the Plant’s wastewater treatment operations, including changing the 700-acre biosolids dewatering and drying operations to a mechanical operation requiring less than 160 acres. The proposed land uses include future areas for WPCP and recycled water operations (629 acres), new roads and economic development areas (387 acres), flood control protection and environmental habitat restoration benefiting endangered and threatened species (1,190 acres), recreational facilities such as parks (42 acres) and trails (16 miles), and other uses (436 acres).
