The group participated in a tour to view the different homes in the Evergreen Specific Plan, the Evergreen Village Market and the campus industrial sites.

I. WELCOME AND INTRODUCTIONS

Cortese welcomed the group and explained that introductions were already done during the tour. He thanked everyone for participating in this Saturday meeting and then invited Prevetti to lead the meeting. Prevetti explained that present today were many people connected to traffic analysis and that the much of today's conversation would be centered on traffic. She added that agenda item #3, Evergreen Area Development Policy, would be weaved into the traffic discussion and therefore not discussed separately. Agenda item #4, community engagement, would be reduced to five minutes.

II. DISCUSS POTENTIAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS AND IMPACTS (INITIAL TRAFFIC ANALYSIS) AND INTRODUCE PROIRITY TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENTS, BOTH LOCAL AND REGIONAL

Hans Larsen, Gary Black and Manuel Pineda presented the [Preliminary Transportation Analysis](#), including an analysis for proposed Evergreen development, identification of transportation improvement options and facilitation of selection of an Evergreen transportation plan. He explained that the projected level of service data is based on 7100 units and then displayed a simulation of the current traffic situation as well as of the proposed additional load with traffic improvements. The presenters then opened the floor to a [Traffic Q&A](#) from the task force and members of the public.
