

Generalized Land Use Plan

- a) More flexibility for employment uses**
- b) More mixed use**
- c) Designate growth areas**
- d) Preserve non-growth areas**
- e) Village Overlay areas generally have underlying commercial designations**

- 2. Reconsider maximum residential densities**
