In October 2005 the Director of Parks, Recreation and Neighborhood Services forwarded a memorandum to the Historic Landmarks Commission (see attached) regarding the items removed from Pellier Park and the open community meeting process proposed to ensure that the future design of the Park reflects the historical significance of the site.

In November 2005 Parks, Recreation and Neighborhood Services held the first committee meeting as part of that process. Historic Landmarks Commission Liaison Pat Colombe, Parks and Recreation Commissioner Mark Swineford, former Historic Landmarks Commissioners Bonnie Bamburg, and Leonard McKay, Pellier family representative Jim McDonald, and neighborhood and Preservation Action Council representatives, were among those in attendance. Commissioner Colombe will report back to the Historic Landmarks Commission at the December meeting (see attached agenda and plans).

The committee expressed interest in understanding the broader development proposals for the North San Pedro area in order to look at the potential for incorporating connections between the Fallon House, Peralta Adobe, and Pellier Park in the new design of the park. Implementation staff will brief the committee on proposed projects in the area and preservation staff will provide process information at an upcoming committee meeting in December. The first community meeting is anticipated in January of 2006.
