SUBJECT: Hitachi Global Storage Technologies (GST) Tour **DATE:** October 21, 2004

A tour of the historic resources located at the Hitachi GST site will be conducted from 3:00 to 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, November 3, 2004 for the Historic Landmarks Commission. Hitachi GST is proposing a General Plan Amendment and Rezoning that is the subject of an upcoming Draft Environmental Impact Report. Early notice about the project was provided to the Commission at the August 4, 2004 meeting. Attached please find a copy of the historic evaluation prepared for the site to provide background to the Commission in advance of the tour.

The Hitachi GST campus is located at 5600 Cottle Road in South San Jose, and is easily accessed from 101 and 85. Please enter the site through the main gate at Cottle Road and Poughkeepsie and give your name to the security guard.

After clearing the gate, take the first left on Boulder.
Take the next right on Endicott.
Take the next left on Sherman.
You will see Building 11 ahead and Building 10 on your right.
Park in any open space in the vicinity of Building 11.
Walk to the open area between Buildings 10 and 11.

You will be met there by Merle Gorman, Manager of Government Relations for Hitachi.

Dinner will be served for the Historic Landmarks Commission at 5:00 p.m. in the Planning Department, City Hall, Room 400.
